





Christopher Maher, MD is a tertiary referral Urogynecologist and Associate Professor at the University of Queensland, Australia. He has been an active researcher in female pelvic floor dysfunction for 15 years and has been rewarded with more than 100 publications in peer reviewed journals, and prizes in national and international meetings in recognition of the work. He is the immediate past president of The Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (RANZCOG) Urogynecology subspecialty, scientific committee chair of IUGA association, and secretary of AGES. He currently leads the Cochrane and International Collaboration Incontinence Pelvic Organ Prolapse Surgery Reviews.



Michael Vardy, MD is a recognized expert in female incontinence, pelvic organ prolapse, menopausal medicine, chronic pelvic pain and sexual dysfunction. He is the Fellowship Director of Female Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery at Mount Sinai School of Medicine, New York, USA which in 2007 became the 27th Urogynecology training program to be accredited by the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology, and more recently by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME). He has performed robotic surgery at Mount Sinai since 2007, and was the first surgeon to be certified by the Robotics committee at EHMC. He founded the Robotic Urogynecology section at Englewood Hospital, Englewood, NJ.



Gil Levy, MD is the director of Urogynecology at the Maynei HaYeshua Hospital in Bnei Brak Israel, since he returned from New York in 2009, where he served as the Director of The Center for Pelvic Floor Dysfunction and Reconstructive Surgery at Maimonides Medical Center in Brooklyn and Staten Island University Hospital. Assistant Professor at the State University of New York Downstate. He established the first multidisciplinary pelvic floor center in the tristate area that combines Urogynecology and Colorectal approach to pelvic floor dysfunction and a fellowship training program. Dr. Levy was the founder of organized Surgical Missions for Fistula Repair to Niger and Kenya.
