Information form concerning the presence a Cesarean Section patient's escort in the Operating Room and about signing Informed Consent

A parturient may be accompanied by an escort in the operating room during Cesarean Section. This service is enabled in order to reduce the stress and anxiety that accompany the process, and to enable the parturient to have a meaningful delivery experience.

- Entry will be allowed to one escort only, according to the parturient's choice and providing that he/she is older than 18 years old, in operations performed under topical anesthesia and the woman is awake. Entry will not be permitted in cases of emergency operations performed due to emergency state of the fetus or the mother.
- Prior to entering the Operating Room, the escort will be briefed by the attending physician and the Operating Room reception nurse, regarding accepted Operating Room behavior procedures and regarding what is about to take place in the OR during his/her stay at the parturient's side.
- The escort will wear clothes suitable for an operating room, will let into the room after preparations and topical anesthesia are completed, accompanied by the midwife.
- The escort undertakes to sit where he so instructed by the medical team, adjacent to the parturient, where he can hold her hand and watch her face, but not the surgery itself.
- The escort undertakes not to take any pictures of the surgical team, the anesthesiologist or the nurses during surgery.
- Throughout the surgery the escort will maintain maximum quiet, will not disturb the proper course of the surgery by asking questions/making comments or otherwise interfere and will be obliged to comply with all the requests of the medical team.
- In the event of the development of conditions requiring the medical team to function quickly and with urgency, the escort will be asked to leave the room and wait in the waiting room.
- In the event the need for general anesthesia arises, the escort will not be able to remain in the operating room.
- The escort undertakes to leave the operating room immediately once he is asked to do so by the surgeon/ anesthesiologist/ pediatrician or the nurse in charge in the room, without asking them to explain their request, in order to provide the parturient with the best care.
- The escort undertakes no to interrupt the pediatrician and the midwife's work once the baby is delivered and not to change his position even after the baby is delivered.

- When the process of taking care of the newborn and preparing his/her for transfer to the neonatal ward, the baby will be presented to the parturient and the escort. The escort will be asked to accompany the midwife for the transfer of the baby to the neonatal ward.
- Subsequently, the escort will wait in the waiting room outside the operating room, until the parturient is delivered to the ward for further hospitalization.
- The escort signs hereby that he had read and understood the content of this document and thereby expresses his consent to act according to its principles and the instructions of the medical team during any one of the operation's stages.
- The escort also declares that he/she is a healthy person who can be in present in situations that may develop at times in operating rooms, that he is aware that sometimes escorts who are not used to medical treatment are seized by weakness, or even loss of consciousness, and that he takes responsibility to the manifestation of such phenomena or any damage he may suffer as a result of the same.
